Covid-19 Precautions

Dear Parents,

This form must be signed and returned before the first day of class in order for your child to attend CCD.

Arrival:

- In grades 3-7, students will enter through the parish center doors in an orderly and socially distanced
 fashion. Then, they will proceed directly to their classrooms avoiding unnecessary conversation and
 contact.
 - O Grades 1 & 2 will enter through the cafeteria doors with their parents and be escorted by their teacher to their classroom.
 - Teachers in grades 1 & 2 will aide with this process.
 - o Grade 8 will enter to the church and proceed to the conference room.
- Prior to attending CCD, parents should make sure their child does not have any Covid-19 symptoms. See CDC.gov for more information
- All children should arrive wearing masks and keep them on at all times until they are outside the building.
- No parents will be admitted to the building during arrival unless dropping off a 1st grader or 2nd grader.
 - Parents may enter if they are dropping off a late child, going to the office, or for another purpose when the PCL gives specific instructions.
- The second session will wait outside their classroom, socially distanced, until the room has been sanitized by staff and a teacher is present. Students should never enter the classroom without a teacher present.

Class Time:

- All students and staff will wear masks for the duration of class, regardless of vaccination.
- Desks will be three feet apart and students are expected to remain in class, in their assigned seats, for the duration of the session.
- Bathroom privileges should be used sparingly as it is a point of close contact between students
 - o If possible, parents should have their children use the bathroom before class time.
 - If the bathroom must be used, students should proceed directly to the bathroom and wash hands thoroughly after.
- Catechists will remain in the front of the classroom and avoid sharing materials between themselves and the students. Students will also refrain from sharing materials.
- No more than 24 students can be in one classroom at the same time.

Dismissal:

- 1st and 2nd grade must be signed out by a parent or guardian. Sign out takes place in the cafeteria; please enter through the cafeteria doors. If someone else is picking up the child, please inform the religious education office.
- For 1st and 2nd grade pick-up, the number of parents in the building at once will be limited.
 - o Please line up outside and wait to be let in. Please wear a mask!
- All other grades dismiss from the parish center doors and students will leave in an orderly and socially distanced fashion.

Sanitation:

All classrooms and facilities being used will be sanitized prior to and after class.

Notification Procedure:

- If your child is ill, do not send them to class.
- If your child tests positive and attended CCD in the past two weeks, please inform the Religious Education Office immediately.
 - This same rule applies to catechists and other staff.
- If a child tests positive, the PCL will contact parents of students who may have come into contact with said student.
- If a catechist tests positive, and came into contact with students, the parents of all students in their class will be notified.
- If class needs to be canceled for any reason, it will take place via email.
 - o An online system may be used so that classes may still take place.

What Students Need

- Their own separate writing utensils or coloring materials (if specified as necessary by the catechist.)
- Their own books and folders (these are issued by the program).
- Hand sanitizer
- A bag or something of the like to carry their things.
- Face mask (an additional should be kept in the bag just in case)
